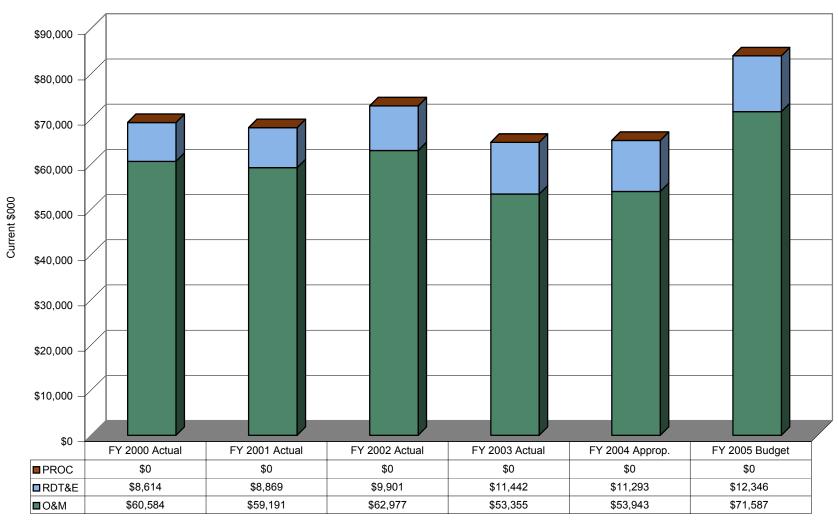

EQ Recurring Costs

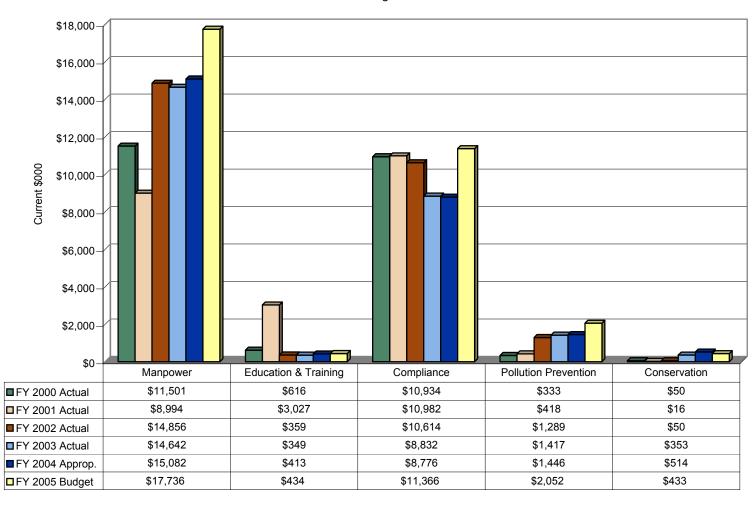

Compliance Recurring

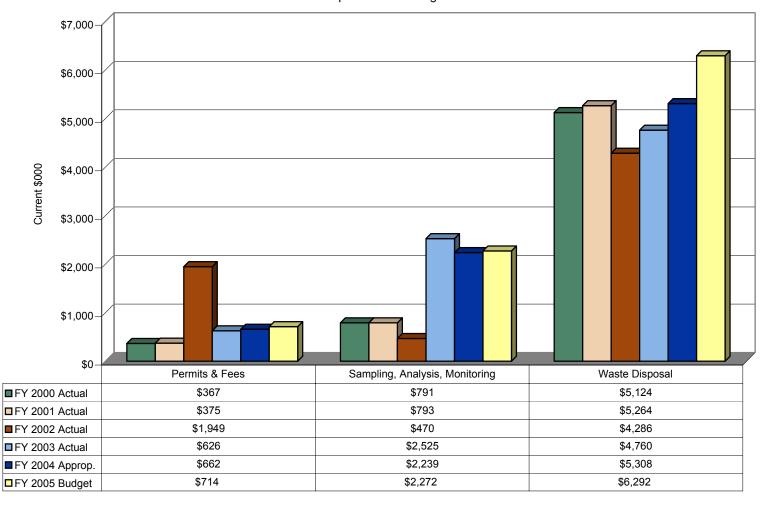
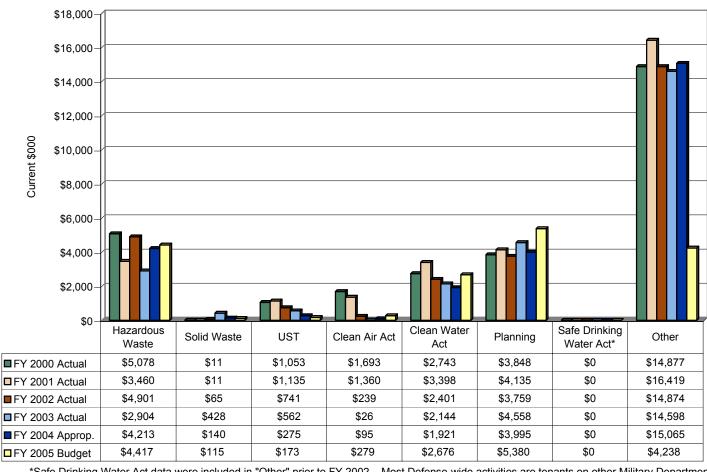

Pollution Prevention Nonrecurring

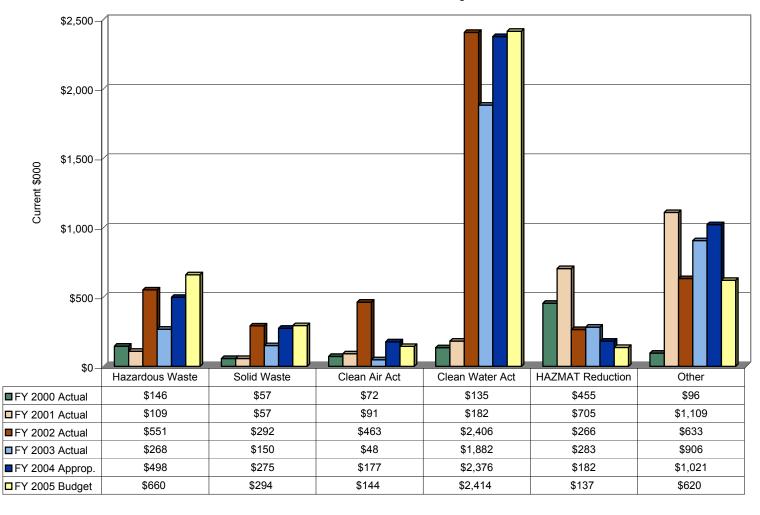
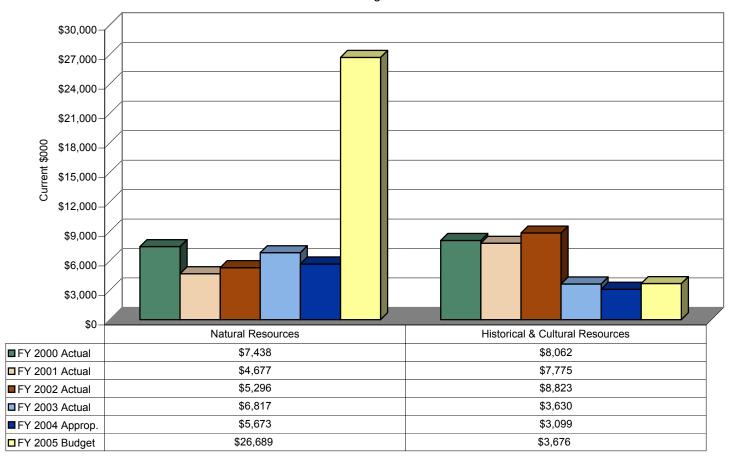
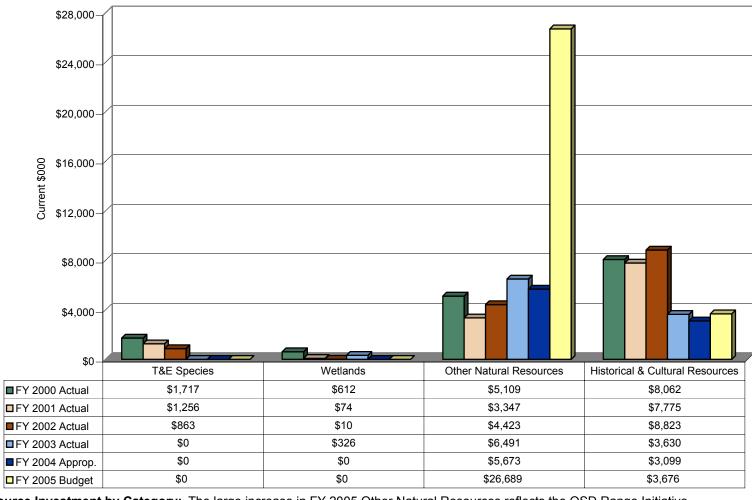
