## **Purpose**

- Senate Report 118-81, page 54, accompanying S. 2587, the Department of Defense Appropriations Bill, 2024, requested the Secretary of Defense and the Service Secretaries to provide quarterly Environmental Restoration Account (ERA) budget execution briefings to the Committees on Appropriations of the House of Representatives and Senate.
- This briefing provides the information requested from the Secretary of Defense and the Service Secretaries.



## DoD's Cleanup Program

- DoD is taking cleanup actions to address contamination from DoD activities nationwide.
- DoD's cleanup program follows the federal cleanup law (i.e., the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980 [CERCLA], also known as "Superfund") to address DoD releases and determine the appropriate cleanup actions based on risk.

# FY 2024 ERA Budget Execution

- In the fourth quarter of FY 2024, the DoD Components obligated \$418.0 million in ERA funding to address DoD releases.
- Through the fourth quarter of FY 2024, the DoD Components obligated \$1.3 billion in ERA funding to address DoD releases.
- The table below provides the total ERA obligations for the Department, as well as the obligations by appropriation and execution account.

### **Conclusion**

- DoD is committed to protecting human health and the environment and is taking action under CERCLA to address contamination from DoD activities nationwide.
- Through the fourth quarter of FY 2024, the DoD Components obligated \$1.3 billion in ERA funding \$196.7 million in the first quarter, \$257.9 million in the second quarter, \$431.1 million in the third quarter, and \$418.0 million in the fourth quarter to address this contamination.
