

NEIL C. STUBITS
Captain, United States Navy

Captain Stubits was born and raised in Lehighton, Pennsylvania. He received his commission through the Officer Candidate program in March of 1983 after graduating from Lehigh University in 1982 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Chemical Engineering.

Following graduation, CAPT Stubits entered the Strategic Weapons Officer community and in 1984 reported to USS JAMES K. POLK (SSBN 645) where he served as Assistant Weapons Officer and Weapons Officer. This tour included four Strategic deterrent patrols and one year of a refueling overhaul conducted at Portsmouth Naval Shipyard.

From 1987 to 1989 CAPT Stubits attended the Naval Postgraduate School in Monterey California where he received a Master of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering and a Mechanical Engineers degree. During this tour, he was accepted into the Engineering Duty Officer program. Following graduation CAPT Stubits reported to Charleston Naval Shipyard where he filled various positions, including Assistant Project Superintendent, Nuclear and Non-nuclear Ship Superintendent and cost advocate for various CNO availabilities.

CAPT Stubits reported to Supervisor of Shipbuilding Groton CT as the Assistant Seawolf Project Officer in 1992. He also served as the waterfront coordinator for the USS HARTFORD (SSN 768) PSA. CAPT Stubits then reported to Naval Submarine Support Facility NLRN as the Assistant Repair Officer (ARO), where he served as the command's representative on the Northeast Regional Maintenance board.

In 1998 he was assigned to Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard and Intermediate Maintenance Facility (PHNSY&IMF). While attached to PHNSY&IMF, CAPT Stubits served as Project Superintendent for the first ever mod-25 DSRA on USS CHARLOTTE (SSN 766) and as Business Operations Officer and Assistant Operations Officer for Intermediate Level Submarine Repair. In March of 2001 he reported to COMSUBLANT and assumed the duties as the Force Maintenance Officer for Commander Submarine Force U.S. Atlantic Fleet.

CAPT Stubits reported to Norfolk Naval Shipyard (NNS) as Assistant Business and Strategic Planning Officer in August 2003. Prior to coming to Indian Head, CAPT Stubits had been serving as the Business and Strategic Planning Officer at NNS since June of 2004.

CAPT Stubits is entitled to wear the Meritorious Service Medal (4 awards), the Navy Commendation Medal (2 awards), the Navy Achievement Medal (2 awards), in addition to other unit and service awards.

He is married to Theresa Ruth Bullock of Monterey, California. They reside in Indian Head, MD with their two dogs.
