(Act of 6/30/14 38 Stat. 430)

This Agreement, made this 20th day of August , 1964, by and between the U. S. Forest Service, and Central Michigan University, represented by N. L. Cuthbert, hereinafter called the Cooperator, Witnesseth that:

WHEREAS, the Forest Service has established a multiple use forest management project in the Mack Lake area, one of the purposes of which is to maintain suitable habitat for the rare Kirtland's Warbler, and

WHEREAS, proper measurement of the success of the management can be made only through careful scientific observation of the Kirtland's Warbler in a variety of ways, and

WHEREAS, the Cooperator has experience in ernithological research and is very interested in the Mack Lake Management project,

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed as follows:

The Cooperator Agrees:

- 1. To carry on scientific research dealing with the Kirtland's Warbler.
- 2. To a large extent, to carry on this research in the Kirtland's Warbler Management Area and in the adjoining areas of the 1946 burn. However, to obtain larger numbers of mests for study, or to establish control areas for comparison with the Mack Lake Area, or to improve his studies in any way, the Cooperator is free to work in any additional areas he chooses, after permission by the District Ranger.
- 3. To make yearly estimates of the adult Kirtland's Warbler populations and nesting success in the Management Area and to generally attempt to determine the effects of the management practices of the Forest Service on the local Kirtland's Warbler population.
- h. To pursus research concerning the effect of local control of the Brown-headed Cowbird on the nesting success of the Kirtland's Warbler and associated species.
- 5. To keep the Forest Service informed of the general progress of his research and to consult with the Forest Service concerning any major changes in his sudy techniques.
- 6. To the best of his ability, and with due credit to the Forest Service, to publish the results of his observations in ornithological journals or other acceptable technical publication sources.

The Forest Service Agreest

l. To allow the Cooperator complete freedom in (a) reasonable use of the Hanagement Area and (b) any reasonable research projects dealing with the Kirtland's Warbler and associated species.

- 2. To advise the Cooperator concerning future activities directed toward managing the vegetation and roads of the area.
- 3. To encourage the Cooperator in his endeavors.
- 4. To limit ornithological research on the 1946 burn to projects which meet with the approval of the Cooperator.
- 5. Taxaupplycoloagaaparatoroakidexaxaaakiloagaayaqaaparatoroakidexaxaaakiloagaa Expenses To reimburse Cooperator for travel and other incidental expenses not to exceed \$200.00.
- 6. To give the Cooperator occasional assistance with equipment or carpenter work.
- 7. To allow the Cooperator to establish a small camp area near Mack Lake and to permit the Cooperator to camp elsewhere on the 1946 burn area when he wishes as long as he uses a cook stove and is a careful camper in every way.

It is Mutually Agreed:

1 .

- 1. Nothing contained in this Agreement shall entitle the Cooperator to any share or interest in the area involved other than the right to use subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Forest Service.
- 2. That nothing in this Agreement shall require the Forest Service to perform any service or expend any funds in the absence of an appropriation therefore by the Congress or a deposit into a cooperative fund.
- 3. No member of or delegate to Congress or Resident Commissioner shall be admitted to any share or part of this Agreement, or to any benefit that may arise therefrom, but this provision shall not be construed to extend to this Agreement if made with a corporation for its general benefit.
- 4. That this Agreement will be effective until 1970, to be renewed upon joint agreement, but may be terminated upon 90 days notice from either party to the other.
