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Allowable Expenses

What are allowable expenses?

- Expenses for which the Army can reimburse partners (reimbursable expenses)
- Authorized in enabling legislation
- Defined further by:
 - Policy
 - OMB Circulars
 - Provisions in Cooperative Agreement





Allowable Expenses

Legal Authorities

- Sikes Act
 - Land management
 - Apply funds off post in a way that benefit natural resources on post
- 10 USC 2684(a)
 - Acquisition of interests in lands
 - Natural resource conservation or encroachment purposes

Quantifying Partner Costs and Contributions



Important to capture all costs

- Competing for limited resources
- FMV limitation as it relates to contribution
- Can't count contributions that aren't quantified
- Can't reimburse costs that aren't quantified
- Auditing
 - Program level
 - Cooperative agreement requirement



Quantifying Partner Costs and Contributions



Costs that need to be captured

- Staff time
- Overhead
- Travel costs
- Services
 - Land survey
 - Biological survey
 - Attorney's fees



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

Red Flags

- •Partner contribution shows no value, hard to determine adequacy of match per new legislation
- •Total cost of doing business (fees and services) not accounted for, partner contribution looks weak
- •Known partner grant funds do not appear





More Examples





- Four most recent parcels (412 acres) show no partner contribution
- Partner is conducting the work
- Camp Blanding
 - Significant partner contribution shown
 - Monetary contribution towards price of interest not separated from other costs
